Ecuador needs a new project. Propose new project to chapter. Need to vote? John is looking
- Madagascar project update Finished travel in November. Travel again this November. Issues with wells breaking from fires. First and second village both having issues (contractor taking short cuts and overuse of wells?). Working with Centennial Rotary for grant for next 10 wells.

- **Togo project update** none. Chris Fahlin working to close the project. Trying to close out project before having to pay fee to EWB-USA
- **Tanzania** Six stalls for 900 students overflow during rainy season. Community is excited and good with 5% contribution and doing even more. Trying to schedule trip with NGO and between rainy seasons. Meeting downtown this month.
